Use/Action : Mouthrinse concentrate to be used by addition of water for pre-, during and post-operative rinsing to clear, cleanse and refresh the mouth.

HEALTH HAZARD INFORMATION

Health Effects

Acute

Swallowed : Ingestion of the concentrate without dilution may cause irritation to the digestive system.

Eye : Direct contact with the concentrate may cause severe irritation.

Skin : Low irritation expected on contact with skin.

Inhaled : Mild irritation possible if high concentrations of the concentrate are inhaled.

Chronic : There are no other known long term health effects expected.

First Aid

Swallowed : Give water to drink to dilute stomach contents and seek medical attention.

Eye : Flush with flowing water for at least 15 minutes and if symptoms persist, seek medical advice.

Skin : Flush skin with flowing water for at least 15 minutes. Remove any contaminated clothing. Seek medical attention. Wash or rinse thoroughly any contaminated area. Staining will be avoided if rinsed/washed immediately.

Inhaled : Remove source of contamination or move person to fresh air area. Apply artificial respiration if breathing has stopped. Seek medical attention.

First Aid Facilities : Ensure eye wash facilities are available in the working area.

Advise to Doctor : Treat symptomatically.

PRECAUTIONS FOR USE

Engineering Controls : Ensure areas are well ventilated.

Personal Protection : Gloves should be worn when handling SWIRL concentrate.

SAFE HANDLING INFORMATION

Storage and Transport : Handle containers with care. Ensure containers are tightly closed and stored in a cool area.

Spills and Disposal : Clean up spills immediately. Wear suitable protective clothing. Remove spills using plenty of water and a soft sponge or towel. Remove immediately to avoid staining or damaging surfaces. Material can be disposed of with general waste or flushed through normal sewer systems.

Fire/Explosion Hazard : None hazardous, not flammable.
