Use/Action : *Clinicare Neutral Detergent* is a neutral pH detergent based on non-ionic surfactants developed for the cleaning of hard surfaces, instruments and equipment. Specifically developed for cleaning surfaces in preparation for disinfection or sterilisation. Surfaces should be rinsed thoroughly or wiped with a clean cloth after cleaning.

## HEALTH HAZARD INFORMATION

### Health Effects

#### *Acute*

Swallowed : No adverse effects expected, however, large amounts may cause nausea, vomiting and gastrointestinal tract irritation.

Eye : A mild eye irritant.

Skin : Contact with skin may cause irritation. Continual skin contact may result in defatting or drying of skin.

Inhaled : No adverse effects expected unless product is deliberately abused.

### First Aid
